Welcome to the Bare Naked Flyball Tournament. Bare Naked Flyball is a 2-day single unlimited tournament with 27 regular, 8 multi-breed, 28 open, and 3 veterans teams. BNF is a low frills tournament, however 1st through 3rd placements will be awarded for all divisions. Be sure to sign up all dogs that have achieved new titles throughout the weekend. If anyone has any suggestions or concerns, please see any Revolution Flyball member for assistance. The judges will be Dave Walt and Jeremy Traas, with relief judging by Carle Lee Detweiler.

Facilities Info and Parking

We are pleased to be back at the Lebanon Valley Fairgrounds Expo Center (<http://www.lebexpo.com/>) and hope that it is a fun experience for all. Please help us maintain flyball's spotless reputation by picking up after your dogs. Please note that the facility has a no alcohol on premises policy. Please do not affix tape or other fastening attachments to walls, floors or ceilings of the building. Crating is outdoors but there is limited crating space available for special needs dogs and/or people. Please contact Lisa at lisadospassos@gmail.com if you need to reserve space. Parking is close to the building so outdoor crating should be readily accessible to the building and there is ample space at the site for exercising the dogs. Dogs are not allowed in the food area or hall near the food area where the vendors are located. Dogs are allowed only in the racing building.

Camping

There are plenty of spaces for camping at the show site. The cost per night is \$20. To get to the camping area, come in the main drive, go past the parking lot and through the chain link fence with the guard gate. No one will be there on Friday night to collect fees, but the camping area is to the right of the road. Each light pole has water & electric hookups. There are approximately 100 spaces. We will be setting up in the hall Friday night so if you need assistance of some kind, you will be able to find us there. Please contact Lisa at lisadospassos@gmail.com to reserve a camping space.

General Tournament Info

There are 66 teams from 26 clubs participating in this year's BNF. The tournament will be two-rings with one schedule. Initial warm up times will be 90 seconds, starting from the time the previous race's box is picked up. After each team's first race, warm ups will be reduced to 60 seconds, again starting from the time the previous race's box is picked up. Racing will be 3/5 format for Regular 1 & 2, Multi 1 and Open 1 & 2. All remaining divisions will be racing a 3/3, 4/4 or 5/5 format as determined by the size of their division.

NAFA C-2 score sheets will be filled out with race schedules pre-printed. They will consist of one double-sided sheet for each team. If you are using stickers, be sure to bring one for each side of the sheet. Please do not bring entire C-2 sheets unless your sheets have the races pre-printed. For your added convenience, Rob has offered to pre-enter team information on the C2 sheets. Please send your team name, dog's names, jump heights if known and CRN's to Rob by Tuesday, April 6, 2010, at rcamoore3@gmail.com. Scoring

- Regular 1- 3/5 format, single round robin followed by double elimination round. Regular 1 double elimination will award points as follows: 6 pts for 1st place, 5 pts for 2nd place, 4 pts for 3rd place 3 pts for 4th place, 2 points for 5th place and 1 point for 6th place. Placements for Regular one will be total points accumulated from the round robin added to the double elimination points.
- Regular 2, Multi 1, Open 1 & 2- 3/5 round robin racing with 1 point for winning the race. No points are awarded for heats. Total accumulation of round robin points determine placement.
- All other divisions-- one point is awarded for each heat won and an additional 2 points for winning the race. No points are awarded for tied heats.
 - In the event of a tied race, each team shall receive one point per heat won and one additional point for tying the race.
- Division placements are awarded by adding up accumulated points.

Ties- In the event of a tie in tournament placement points, ties will be decided by: 1) fastest time head to head, 2) fastest time overall in the division, 3) tie breaker race best 2/3.

Friday night Single Dog Streaking (well...racing)

Back by popular demand, Friday night single dog racing will start at 6 pm and ends at 8pm. Both rings will be available Friday night. One ring will be assigned for single dog head-to-head racing for 5 heats of racing with the EJS system. The second ring will also be open without lights for five minutes of training time. The head-to-head ring and training ring will be available for \$5.00 each. Registration will begin on site at 5:30pm and is on a first come, first serve basis. Cost is \$5 for 5 runs or \$5 for five minutes of ring time. Clothing optional for dogs, as for people...well, just keep it legal!
